Rules

1. All species of cage birds may be entered into the Pet Section, provided it is kept as a pet. Birds entered into this section are **NOT** precluded from other show rules.
2. Pet Birds must be entered in house cages (not show cages), and pet birds may have clipped wings.
3. All cage doors must be wired shut.
4. There must be NO GRIT or any other abrasive materials in the cage. All cages must contain sufficient food and water for the bird.

Display Section

Rules

1. Displays will be judged strictly on their overall eye appeal and not on the strict quality of the birds exhibited.
2. The exhibitor must provide their own cage and decorate it in any manner they wish within the rules.
3. All display must have sufficient food and water for the birds being displayed. Feeding and watering is the responsibility of the owner.
4. **NO GRIT**, crushed rock, or other abrasive material may be used in loose form, either decoratively or for feeding. Such materials may be used for effect only if cemented in place.

General Show Rules

Please Read Carefully

Every Exhibitor entering birds onto this show shall be regarded as having read these show rules and thereby accepting and abiding by them.

1 Every care will be given to the exhibits, and the birds will be attended by experienced stewards. However, no responsibility can be assumed by the Vancouver Island Cage Bird Society for any loss, damage or accident to any exhibitor's property, or for the mistakes in entry or the release of exhibits.

2 No entry will be accepted without a water dish and adequate food. **THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Drinkers will not be provided and may be removed for judging. All exhibits must show in the standard show cage for that species. House cages are allowed in the pet section only.

3 The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

4 Entry Fee: \$2.00 per cage (Maximum \$30.00)

5 Entry Forms:

- a) A separate entry form must be used for each division. Filled out in full.
- b) All entry forms must show the Exhibitor's name and full address; must be printed legibly, must be signed by the Exhibitor.
- c) Exhibitor status is maintained in each Division separately (e.g. If a Champion Budgie Exhibitor starts showing Type Canaries, they may show as a Novice until they qualify as a Champion). All family members must maintain the same status as the most advanced exhibitor in that division (except juniors).

6 Exhibit Entry Hours: We encourage exhibitor's to enter their birds on **Friday Night** to allow the birds to settle overnight.

Local Entries between 6:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. **Friday.**

Out Of Town Entries should be entered **Friday** night, but may be entered on **Saturday** morning between 8:00 a.m. and 9:30a.m. We appreciate everyone's adherence to this rule in order that all birds can be judged on a equal basis. **There will be absolutely no exceptions for Saturdays entry time unless pre-arranged with the show manager.**

7 **No Person**, including the owner, shall handle any bird placed in the Show Hall for competition without express permission, and in the presence of a Show Supervisor.
NO EXCEPTIONS.

8 Once an Exhibit has been accepted at the Show, it shall not be removed from the benches prior to being checked out by the Division Supervisor.

9 All Exhibitors may begin removing their birds from the show at 1:00 p.m. Sunday. All birds must be checked out by the appropriate supervisor. **THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

10 All birds must be the bonafide property of the Exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to the Show. Current Year birds **MUST** be shown in the name of the breeder.

11 Grit is not to be used an ANY cage (to avoid damage to the Show Hall Floors).

12 No paper can be used in the bottom of show cages - seed only, except designated Finch and Softbill exhibits.

13 If there are 5 times more entries of any color or species in any class, a special class may be made up at the discretion of the Division Supervisor. All birds accepted by the Club will be Judged.

14 **NOVICE:** An exhibitor may show as novice for an unlimited time or three best novice wins in three calendar years, in a Fall Show, will force an Exhibitor to move to the next status. They may finish the current year in which these wins were made as a novice.

15 **INTERMEDIATE:** (Budgerigars Only) An exhibitor may show as intermediate for an unlimited time or three best intermediate wins in three calendar years, in a Fall Show, Exhibitor to move to the next status. They may finish the current year in which these will force an wins were made as a intermediate.

16 **CHAMPION:** Any Exhibitor not covered under the previous two levels must show as a Champion.

17 **JUNIOR:** (6 to 16 years of age) Only birds entered in Junior classes will compete for Junior awards. The best Junior in each Division will be judged against the best Novice and Champion exhibits for the best in Division awards. Any wins at this level will not affect Junior status.

18 All entries in Current Year classes must be banded with closed bands that have been registered to the Exhibitor's, Juniors included.

19 While the exhibitors are allowed to watch the judging, the supervisors have the right to revoke this privilege should there be any difficulty in maintaining order.

20 **The decision of the Judge is FINAL.** The judge has full power to withhold any award for want of merit.


21 The Judge must write on the cage tags the exhibits position in classes. E.g. 1/1, 2/5.

22 A Judge may handle or inspect any exhibit with the consent of the Division Supervisor.

- 23 A Division Supervisor may change classification of any entry considered to be entered incorrectly.
- 24 All persons attending the Show are responsible for their actions and those of their children. Anyone found creating a disturbance will be evicted from the Show Hall and may be refused re-entry.
- 25 **NO SMOKING ANYWHERE IN THE SHOW HALL.**
- 26 **ALL BIRDS** admitted to the Show Hall **MUST** be caged for the duration of the Show.
- 27 Complaint Procedure: Any Exhibitor who feels they have a justified complaint, provided it concerns them, upon posting a \$20.00 bond with the Show Manager, may state their complaint in writing to the Show Committee. All such complaints must be filed no later than one hour after the judging is complete. If the complaint is found to be justified the bond will be returned and the appropriate actions taken. If the complaint is found to be unfounded the bond will be forfeited to the host club (s).
- 28 Special roles pertaining to some entries in Divisions 3 & 4 are listed prior to the Hookbill Classifications.
- 29 The Show Committee reserves the right to alter or waive any rule in this catalogue **except** rule #20.
- 30 Ship - Ins: Phone show manager for full details at least 14 days prior to the show date.
