THE WCBA STORY

In the Fall of 1980 while sailing back to Vancouver aboard a BC Ferry after a Fall Show in Victoria, a group of Budgie fanciers were once again lamenting the fact that it would be nice to have a specialty Budgerigar Association. It was decided that the time was right to form a specialty club designed to bring together all the serious Budgerigar fanciers into one Association.

The founding members who worked together to form the Western Canada Budgerigar Association were: Rick Colman, Al Consiglio, Dick Boulter, Jim Marshall and Carl Slavin. The inaugural President was Al Consiglio, Secretary was Dick Boulter.

The WCBA normally puts on two Shows per year, A spring Show in early June, and a fall Show in October. Also some years having a lawn Show and picnic, Members also attend other Shows in and around B.C. and also in other Provinces and into the United States.

Meeting every month with the exception of July and August, originally meetings were held in members homes, so that members would have an opportunity to see other fanciers Birds and aviary layouts. From its early inception WCBA has had an aggressive list of items to be addressed, all for the betterment of the hobby, the birds, and its members. To date WCBA has moved at lightning speed making many changes and continues to evolve and progress.

It is the innovative thinking among WCBA members that has promoted new ideas in the care, keeping and breeding of Budgerigars. Although its membership is modest in numbers, it is made up for in terms of quality and enthusiasm to the credit of its dedicated members.



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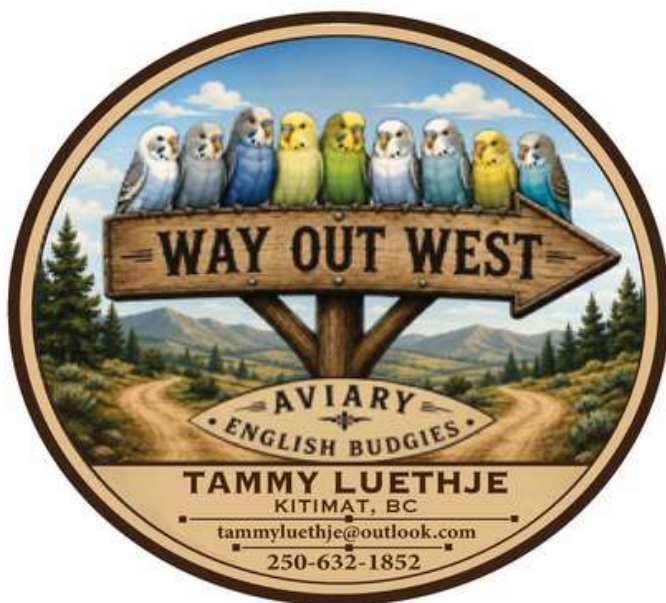

RING NUMBERS ARE REQUIRED ON ENTRY FORMS, FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN BEING EXCUSED FROM THE SHOW!

THE SHOW MANAGER SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO CHECK ALL LEG BAND NUMBERS OF BIRDS EXHIBITED IN SHOW.

SHOW CAGES MUST BE CLEAN, PLAIN SEED ON CAGE FLOOR. EXHIBITOR TO SUPPLY FINGER DRINKERS PLACED ON CAGES AFTER JUDGING IS COMPLETED.

JUDGING TO START AT 10am. JUDGING AS PER WCBA FORMATT. JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.

BIRD SALES PERMITTED, 10% TO WCBA.

ENTRIES SHALL REMAIN IN SHOW HALL UNTIL RELEASED BY SHOW MANAGER.

No birds shall be double banded, solid or split, in non compliance, they shall be disqualified from the Show.

My first exposure to Budgerigars was at the age of 10, I had a cousin who lived in Ayr a town on the west coast of Scotland who bred and exhibited Budgerigars, that summer I came home with 3 pairs which started my fascination with the Exhibition Budgerigar.

In 1957 my mother passed away, the family decided to uproot and move to Canada we settled in Burlington, Ontario, after becoming established in my exciting new country, some 12 years later my sisters boyfriend was going out of town for a week and asked her to baby sit his two Budgies, well when I saw these fine specimens they were definitely not pet stock, so when he came back I asked him where he got these fine specimens, turned out I visited their source and this gentleman referred me to the Hamilton & District Budgerigar & Cage Bird Society, of which I became a member and eventually was President for a few terms.

Today, I still attribute my passion to those early years in the Canadian fancy with guidance from great Budgerigar people like Niel O'Brien, Len Corner, Rod MacDonald, Harry Chernenko, Don Spittles, Nick Murray, Bruce Aspden, Lou Lavelette and many more.

The one who had the greatest influence on my fascination with the Budgerigar was a fellow Scot my dear friend and mentor the late Thomas Orr Knox.

Due to a job opportunity in British Columbia in 1975 my wife Dorothy, children Mark and Jillian, moved from Ontario to British Columbia which has been home ever since, currently I reside in the beautiful Upper Fraser River Valley in a town called Chilliwack.

One of my dearest accomplishments since moving to British Columbia has been my ongoing involvement with the "Western Canada Budgerigar Association" of which I am a founding member.

I also feel very fortunate to be in an area where the climate is very friendly and there is a fair number of quality fanciers in all varieties of birds.

3. To disseminate information on the study & practical application on all aspects of the science of aviculture through the publication of the Avicultural Journal.

4. To support recognized expert aviculturists who are endeavouring to breed rare and endangered species to ensure their future preservation.

5. To foster a greater understanding of the proper care and management of pet birds among the general public.

6. To act on behalf of all Canadian aviculturists to assist all levels of government preparing informed legislation and policy, where required, relating to aviculture, and to assist affiliate societies in similar endeavours on a provincial, regional, or municipal level.

7. To establish standards for the exhibition of birds in Canada, ensure their proper implementation through the maintenance of a national Judge's Panel, and to allocate and sponsor an annual Canadian National Bird Show to provide a large scale comparison of birds bred to these standards.

8. To provide a national identification leg band registry, coding service, and a Canadian service, and a Canadian source of supply of such bands for affiliate societies.
